674 Recreation Ground. Very quiet. Michael Glover has agreed to remove the western end goalpost for the summer. Cllr Kerley will speak to Mr Glover. Meet in November before setting precept.

Cllr Rowitt declared an interest, the skate park is dangerous and needs repairing, this has been reported to health and safety.

675 Approval of R2 money for recreation ground. Total bill for levelling amounted too £13160.20 plus VAT, need to approve an extra £2626.86. SDC have agreed to pay full amount out of R2. Cllr Smith proposed DPC pay full amount, Cllr Fry 2nd all in favour. Need to point out that all quotes submitted must be up to date.

676 Affordable Housing. Cllr Fry has contacted Raglan and requested forecast of dates (finishing, viewing and who gets one). Need to look into dropped kerb as not done yet. **Ongoing**

677 Best Kept Village Competition. Dinton came first, great improvement in the Churchyard and also recycling area. Dinton Parish Council wish to thank all parishioners for their efforts, press office will also do a piece. **Press Officer**
