6. Urgent Planning matters:
 - a. Nothing had been heard from SDC or Highways about the Parish Councils expressed desire to consult further re the siting of a pedestrian refuge (traffic island) on the B3089 beside Pembroke Terrace. **Action: Cllr C. Smith to investigate.**

After note: as of 16/11/07 WCC case officer opined that refuge should be sited as shown on plans. SDC is calling S/2007/1569 in for Western Area Committee.

- b. The formation of a steering group dealing with the B3089 was discussed. It was agreed that the PC should not be represented on this body, although individual members could be involved in a private capacity and that it would be helpful if a number of civic minded volunteers could be found.
- c. It was Agreed that "Highways Matters" be included as a standing agenda point on future Agendas.
- d. It was agreed that a "Draft Copy" of Planning Minutes be displayed on the Parish

notice board at Dinton Stores.

7. Notification of LPA planning decisions: Planning Applications S/2007/1325 (Wrights Farm), S/2007/1594 (Speargate), S/2007/1587 (Stone House) and Trees in Conservation Areas S/2007/1695, S/2007/1698 & S/2007/1725 were all approved.

After Note: The committee was made aware at short notice on 30 October 2007 of S/2007/1963, of an application in the Parish of Chilmark which would potentially affect traffic through Dinton. As the Public consultation ended on 01 November 2007 there was insufficient time to call a public meeting. The chairman drafted a response in support of the Chilmark PC objection which was put to members to vote upon. The vote was carried (Four for, Nil against and Three abstentions).
