

Dinton Parish Council
Planning Committee

A meeting of the Council to discuss Planning Matters was held in Dinton Village Hall on 21st April 2008 at 1930 hrs.

Present were Cllrs. L. Campey (until 2030), J. Fry (Chairman of Planning), G. Gillott, D. Kerley, V. O'Keefe, C. Smith & A Taylor.

Members of the Public: NIL

1. Apologies for absence were received from: Nil (all present)
2. Minutes of the previous Planning meeting: Members had been given insufficient opportunity to examine minutes and approval was deferred.
3. Actions from Previous Minutes: Not discussed.
4. Declarations of interest: All councillors declared personal interests arising from the Local Development Framework (LDF) document.
5. The following Planning Matters were discussed:

The LDF Core Strategy was discussed in some detail with respect to plans for the 4 Rivers and Salisbury Community areas in which Dinton has been located and wider issues which affect the District as a whole. The 3 proposed Dinton sites identified in the accompanying Strategic Housing Land Availability (SHLA) Study were also discussed. **Action: Cllr Fry** to inform Forward Planning of the points in the LDF that the council were unhappy with and of the unsuitability of site 183 (Land adjacent to "Spire Gate") identified in the SHLA.

6. Cllrs Kerley and Smith gave a report as to the Western Area Committee's lack of decision on application S/2008/0408 (Westfields lighting). The application has been referred back to the Planning Office for negotiation and decision although the Office appears to have been given limited choices as to the decision to which it may come to.
7. Parish Liaison Group (PLG)- Further to e-mail correspondence, members confirmed that it was the belief of Dinton PC that the PLG should remain a conduit for liaison between Parish Councils without empowerment or constitution. **Action: Cllr Smith** to inform the PLG of the Dinton PC view and report back in due course the consensus of the other PCs.
8. Forthcoming Planning Applications: S/2008/654&655 (combined application) & S/2008/735
9. Date of next meeting: The Planning Committee was due to meet 29th April 2008.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 2135hrs.
