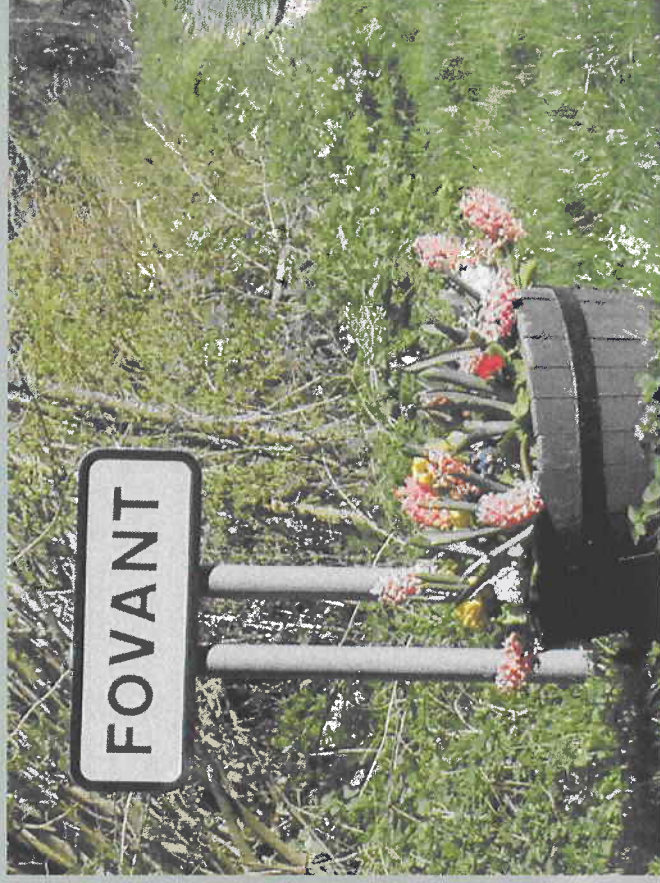

Volunteer Litter-Pickers

Litter can be as small as a sweet wrapper, or as large as a bag of rubbish, or it can mean lots of items scattered about. The legislation also specifically clarifies that discarded gum products, cigarette ends, and matches are types of litter.

The offence of *Leaving Litter* (section 87 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990) applies where a person throws down, drops or otherwise deposits any litter in any place in the open air in the area of a principal litter authority to which the public has access with or without payment, and leaves it.

One of the most difficult items for anyone to deal with is Dog fouling; please encourage owners to pick up their dog litter and to dispose of it safely.
