1. Minutes:

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

2. New Ground:

Terry reported on progress with the Development Project. Building work was now scheduled to begin in the November. It was now clear that there would be a significant shortfall in the budget. Guy had discussed the matter with the Town Council who had been very supportive of the Club and the development. Guy hoped to put a formal request to the Council shortly. The Sunday 1st XI had cruised to the Division 4 title, the forth in five years. The Sunday II side had picked up a well deserved victory in its last game and had fielded a full side in every game (except one).

It was agreed that the biggest success had been the emergence of some very talented young players that augured well for the future of the Club.

The Committee gave thought to the performances that merited awards at the Annual Dinner.
