16/14	<p><b><u>Planning Applications</u></b>  <u>14/04194/LBC Corner Cottage, Becketts Lane – demolish existing extension on east and erect new single storey side extension.</u> The PC supports nemcon.  <u>14/02217 Sarum House and Wandle House, Cow Drove, Chilmark – demolition of existing 2 detached dwellings and erection of 9 dwellings, with associated parking, turning, landscaping, improvements to existing access and a footpath link.</u> This application has been withdrawn.  The Chmn reported that the application <u>13/07359 Ful 88 Ridge – proposed detached home office/yoga room</u> had been passed without any conditions and costs were awarded against the Planning Cttee.</p>	
17/14	<p><b><u>Neighbourhood Plan</u></b>  The Chmn and Clerk have attended seminars on this subject. The Chmn reported that the advice was that the Core Strategy meets the requirements of the “small village” and there is no need to produce a Neighbourhood plan. They are expensive to produce but if anyone is interested they can research the matter. A Neighbourhood Plan can recommend development.
