22/13	<p><u>Wilts Cllr's Report</u></p> <p>Wilts Cllr B Wayman thanked the PC for using the Leisure Credit Scheme which is to be encouraged. She reported that there had been a zero percent increase in Council from the Police and Fire Brigade and more funding is to be put in to older people. There is an increase in the numbers of children taken in to care so more funds will be required. More funds (2 million pounds) is to be allocated to Highways because roads suffered due to bad weather. The Village Hall Grants Cttee is being disbanded by Community First so more applications will be made through the Area Board. The Chmn explained that the Playgroup which is a separate body from the PC applied to the Area Board but they were made to feel unwelcome. Wilts Cllr Wayman said WCC are spending public money so they are very careful but if the Reading Room were to apply for a grant they would be fully entitled.</p>	
23/13	<p><u>Highway Matters</u></p> <p>The Chmn reported that there had been no response from Mr Button re: the entrance to Rock Cottage. Cllr EP said that the gates were supposed to be set back 3.5 m from the highway. The Chmn wrote to the Planning Officer, Mr Bidwell. The matter was passed to the Enforcement Officer who explained he was not qualified and that Mr Button, WCC Highways, should confirm if it is in accordance with the plans.
